GENERAL TECHNOLOGY TERMS

CONNECT

connect /kə'nekt/

v. describe the action of establishing (making) communication with the Internet or with another device (computer equipment) such as a monitor, modem, etc.

- 连接
- Can you please show me how to connect my laptop to the central printer?

connection /kəˈnekʃn/

- n. the communication between two or more computer devices, or a link to the Internet.
- 连接
- I'm having problems with my Internet connection.

INSTALL

install /In'stail/

- to set up or make a computer or application (software program) ready for use.
- 安装; 设置
- On my first day of work, my supervisor sent the technical support team to install a new computer for me.
- Uninstall 卸载

installation / Installation/

- the act of installing a computer or application
- 安装,装置
- Installation of the new system will take several days.

NETWORK

network / 'netw3:rk/

- a system of connected computers and other devices such as printers that exchange data with each other.
- 网络
- Before we open for business, I need to get my office computer network set up and tested.

OPERATING SYSTEM

operating system / aparetin/

- a set of programs that control the way a computer system works, especially how its memory is used and how different programs work together
- 操作系统
- a computer/PC operating system
- A leading economist denied that the firm has a monopoly in the PC operating system market.

SOFTWARE

software /'spftweə(r)/

- the instructions that control what a computer does; computer programs
- 软件
- to install/run a piece of software 安装/运行一个软件
- A leading economist denied that the firm has a monopoly in the PC operating system market.

HARDWARE

hardware /'hairdwar/

- the machinery and electronic parts of a computer system
- 硬件
- The machine allows multitasking without the need to buy extra hardware.
- The thieves stole thousands of dollars worth of computer hardware.

MONITOR

monitor /'monitə(r)/

- 1. n. the video screen used to display information on your computer.
- 监视器; (计算机)显示器
- I work on the computer most of the day. I find that using a bigger monitor reduces (lessens) the strain on my eyes.
- 2. v. describe the action of keeping watch over a technical fault or process running on a computer.
- 监控
- The technical support team will monitor my computer over a period of time to see what's causing this problem.

BOOT UP

boot up

- to turn on a computer and have it ready for use.
- You could also say "start up" or "power up."
- 启动
- There seems to be a problem with my laptop. It wouldn't boot up this morning.
- There seems to be a problem with my laptop. I couldn't boot it up this morning.

reboot

- start your computer again
- V. If you're still getting errors on your computer, you might

ACCESS

access /'ækses/

- 1. v. to access, when used in IT, means entering and using a computer, website or application
- 访问, 存取
- This is a shared computer only for the use of our department. You can get the password from me if you need to access it.
- 2. n. the act of accessing the computer. It's commonly used with the verb "grant" to mean give permission to use.
- 使用权
- I'm afraid we can't grant anyone access to our department's computers.

LOG IN & LOG OUT

- log in & log out
- Some websites and applications need you to log in before you can enter and use them. To log in refers to the process where you enter certain information before you're allowed to access a website or application.
- I' ve forgotten my password so I can' t log in to Gmail anymore.
- The opposite of log in is **log out** which is what you should do to exit a site or application.
- Don't forget to log out before you leave especially if you're using a shared computer.
- Sometimes the terms sign in and sign out are also used.

DOWNLOAD

download /ˌdaʊnˈloʊd/

- To download is a verb you' 11 often hear in IT to talk about transferring data or information from a main computer source to another device.
- 下载
- I need to download the photos of my business trip to my computer for today's presentation.

upload /ˌʌpˈloʊd/

- 上传
- All you need to do is upload the files on to your web space.

UPGRADE

upgrade /'ApgreId/

- It's not unusual to hear this word in a fast-changing field like IT. The verb to upgrade means to bring your computer (or other device) up to date with the latest hardware or software.
- 使(机器、计算机系统等)升级;提高;改进
- Our management is confident that our business will improve if we upgrade to the latest computer equipment.

ANALYZE

analyze / məlaiz/

- The verb to analyze is used quite often in IT when there's a need to study data, information or even a technical problem closely. For instance, you might analyze product trends or a problem with your communications network.
- 分析
- This is not a problem with a simple solution. We need time to analyze why your laptop won't boot up.

analysis /əˈnæləsɪs/

- The noun form analysis refers to the act of, and the result of analyzing the data or problem.
- According to the technical support team's analysis, you're better off buying a new laptop than trying to repair this one.

BROWSE

browse /brauz/

- The verb to browse is used in IT to look over information casually without being too detailed.
- 浏览(信息)
- Before you come to the meeting, please browse online to get some ideas of the current trends in office furniture.

browser /'braʊzər/

- The noun **browser**, as you may already know, refers to the program on your computer that allows you to open and use websites on the Internet.
- 浏览程序,浏览器(用于在互联网上查阅信息)
- If your browser doesn't work, try closing and reopening it.

FILE

file /faIl/

- The noun **file** in IT refers to a collection of data or information organized under a specific name and stored in a computer's folder.
- (计算机的)文件
- to access/copy/create/delete/download/save a file 打开/复制/新建/删除/下载/保存文件
- Please save each year's sales data in a different **file** for easy reference.
- What's the filename you used to save last year's sales data?

BACK UP

back up

- The phrasal verb back up is often used in IT to mean making a copy of data and files to protect them against accidental loss.
- 备份
- It's always a good idea to back up your computer regularly.
- My laptop has been switching itself on and off. I think I'd better back it up after work tonight.

backup

- Backup, when spelled as one word, is a noun referring to the copy of files and data that you' ve made to keep.
- The system administrator does a full **backup** of the system every weekend.

PERFORM

perform /per'foirm/

- In IT, we're often concerned about how the computer system performs. The verb to perform refers to how fast a computer can process information.
- 运行: 执行
- Are you sure that my computer will **perform** better if I upgrade my RAM (computer memory)?

performance /pər'fo:rməns/

- The noun **performance** is used to talk about the speed and capacity (workload) of the computer.
- 性能
- Upgrade your RAM (computer memory) and you won't find any reason to complain about your computer's performance.

HIGH TECHNOLOGY

high technology / high tech

- highly advanced technological development
- 高科技
- Obviously, in high technology businesses, software and sophisticated designs are at the core of the business.

MOBILE DEVICE

mobile device /ˈmoʊbl/ / dɪˈvaɪs/

- any piece of electronic equipment such as a cell phone or small computer that you can use in different places
- 移动设备,移动装置
- Looking for a new game to play on your mobile device?
- Some mobile devices—like tablets, e-readers, and smartphones are powerful enough to do many of the same things you can do with a desktop or laptop computer.

TABLET

tablet /'tæblət/

- a small, flat computer that is controlled by touching the screen or by using a special pen
- 平板电脑
- This tablet PC converts into a smoothly working notebook with a keyboard addition.

APPLICATION

application / æpli kein/

- a system of connected computers and other devices such as printers that exchange data with each other.
- 应用程序; 应用软件
- a database application 数据库应用软件
- Email is the most often-used application.

INNOVATION

innovation / Inə veIn/

- the introduction of new things, ideas or ways of doing sth
- 创新,创造
- an age of technological innovation 技术革新的时代
- We must promote originality, inspire creativity and encourage innovation.

ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE

Artificial Intelligence / airtifil/ /intellidgens/

- the study of how to produce machines that have some of the qualities that the human mind has, such as the ability to understand language, recognize pictures, solve problems, and learn
- 人工智能
- To understand "natural language," computers must be equipped with artificial intelligence.
- Every coin has two sides, and artificial intelligence is no exception.

AUTONOMOUS VEHICLE

autonomous vehicle /o:'tonemes/ /'vi:ek1/

- A vehicle, such as a car or truck, that uses technology and sensors to drive without the need for human assistance.
- 自动驾驶
- As an autonomous vehicle, it is capable of sensing its environment and navigating without human input.
- Uber, Tesla and Google are just some of the big businesses working on self-driving technologies.

BIOMETRICS

biometrics /, baiə' metriks/

- the use of detailed information about someone's body, for example the patterns of colour in their eyes, in order to prove who they are
- 生物识别
- The U.S. Department of Homeland Security describes biometrics as being "unique physical characteristics" that can be utilized for "automated recognition." Think fingerprints, iris(虹膜) scans and voice recognition.

Voice biometrics forecast to grow at 22.8 percent rate to \$3.9B by 2026

Access control, image recognition, biometric middleware markets strong

MACHINE LEARNING

machine learning

- the process of computers changing the way they carry out tasks by learning from new data, without a human being needing to give instructions in the form of a program
- 机器学习
- His research helped shape the field of machine learning, bringing computers closer to the realm of human thought.
- A robot has taught itself to smile, frown, and make other human facial expressions using machine learning.

BLOCKCHAIN


blockchain / bloktfein /


a system used to make a digital record of all the occasions a cryptocurrency (= a digital currency such as bitcoin) is bought or sold, and that is constantly growing as more blocks are added

The first prominent use of blockchain was bitcoin.

Blockchain technology has the potential to transform business operating models.





cloud computing

- the use of services, computer programs, etc. that are on the internet rather than ones that you buy and put on your computer
- 云计算
- Cloud computing is described by Microsoft
 Azure as "the delivery of computing
 services" like software, servers, storage
 and databases, over the internet, or
 "cloud."

CONTACTLESS PAYMENT

contactless / kontæktles/

- A cashless method of paying for goods and services. Mostly it's used to describe bank cards, identity cards, etc. that can operate by being put close to the machine that uses them, and that do not have to be put into the machine
- 无接触支付
- Contactless payment technology can be incorporated into a range of devices, from debit and credit cards to smartwatches and smartphones.

FINTECH

fintech /'fintek/

- An amalgamation of the words "financial" and "technology."
- It describes the use of technology to deliver financial services and products to consumers.
- 金融科技
- Fintech is not a new industry, it's just one that has evolved very quickly.
- Mobile banking is a large part of the fintech industry. In the world of personal finance, consumers have increasingly demanded easy digital access to their bank accounts, especially on a mobile device.

WEARABLES

wearables / werəbls/

- something that can be worn that contains computer technology or can connect to the internet
- These devices are usually connected to the internet and can carry out a range of tasks, from paying for goods and services using contactless technology to monitoring and analyzing a user's heart rate.
- 可穿戴设备
- Check out our reviews of the biggest names in wearables including smartwatches and fitness trackers.
- The applications of wearables are limited only by the imagination.

INTERNET OF THINGS

Internet of things (IoT)

- objects with computing devices in them that are able to connect to each other and exchange data using the internet
- 物联网("万物相连的互联网",是互联网基础上的延伸和扩展的网络,将各种信息传感设备与网络结合起来而形成的一个巨大网络,实现在任何时间、任何地点,人、机、物的互联互通)
- Think of devices that are connected to the internet and able to "talk" to one another. One example would be a thermostat(恒温器) in your home that you control with your smartphone from your office.
- Cloud applications will be used by billions of devices of all kinds, all connected to the internet of things.
- The internet of things might, for example, involve smart trash cans that can signal when they need to be emptied.

VIRTUAL REALITY

Virtual Reality (VR) /'v3:rtʃuəl/ /ri'æləti/

- a set of images and sounds, produced by a computer, that seem to represent a place or a situation that a person can take part in
- Virtual reality is designed to immerse a person into a completely digital world.
- 虚拟现实
- One day virtual reality will revolutionize the entertainment industry.
- Using their expertise and virtual reality technology architects recreated the Theater of Pompey in Rome.

BIG DATA ANALYTICS

big data analytics

- Big data analytics examines large amounts of data to uncover hidden patterns, correlations and other insights.
- 大数据分析
- Big data analytics helps organizations harness (利用) their data and use it to identify new opportunities. That, in turn, leads to smarter business moves, more efficient operations, higher profits and happier customers.
